

Management

- Small team that supports and coordinates the ordering of all election material
- Manages over 500 unique items which include communication items available in 48 different languages

Asset Management

- Small team that tracks all assets including IT equipment and office furniture
- Manages **9851** unique items

Distribution Centre

- 130,000 sq ft facility
- Team of ~20 to receive, handle and store materials
- Orders received at Distribution Centre, packaged into kits, then lots and distributed across Canada
- IT equipment stored at separate facilities

General Election During a Pandemic

- A new operational approach to deliver an election in the context of a pandemic
- Implementing physical distancing and other public health guidelines at polling places and local offices
- Procuring PPE and single-use pencils to be provided to electors
- Increasing the capacity of the existing vote-by-mail system
- Expanding virtual training for electoral workers in order to limit the number of in-person interactions
