



## EXCELLENCE IN PROCUREMENT

### **Contract Management Initiative Team – Shared Services Canada**

Shared Services Canada's Enterprise IT Procurement Directorate developed a Contract Management Initiative with the goal to better inform stakeholders on the status of contracts in order to enhance procurement planning and mitigate potential risks.

The Governance Team established a Director-level monthly Contract Management Review Committee to improve awareness on the status of higher-risk contracts with information cascading down, and a branch specific expansion and wider distribution of the monthly Expiring Contracts List to provide insight from a bottom-up perspective, offering information at a granular level.

This initiative has facilitated closer engagement between Contracting Authorities and SSC Business Lines to ensure that all parties play their part in contract management and public funds are well stewarded.
