PROCUREMENT PLANNING

- Procurement planning for FY19-20 activities have been initiated for the first time with the Agency.
- The plans submitted will be reviewed and adjusted as required. Quarterly meetings will take place to review procurement planning and procurement results with key stakeholders to improve early engagement and collaboration.
- This will allow SPD to better respond and meet Agency priorities and to strengthen the financial management and prioritization of business requirements.

IMPORTANCE OF EARLY COLLABORATION WITH STAKEHOLDER

- Bi-weekly teleconference with stakeholder to discuss priorities and provide status on ongoing procurement activities
 - Creates valuable relationship (open line communication)
- Assist the Strategic Procurement Division in better planning our resources for upcoming priorities
- Relays proper expectations of the procurement processes to the client.



COMPLEXITIES WITH PROCURING DOGS

- Challenges with procuring dogs for the Detective Dog Program.
 - Compared to the RCMP and DND, the CBSA does not procure purebred German Shepherd. The Agency's mission is not to install fear amongst travellers as a result we tend to select common dog breeds such as Labrador, Cocker Spaniels.
 - 90 days trial period
 - Goods Delegations of \$25,000
- Current shortage of readily available dog in the United States
